Year 7 pupils who are below level 4 in English, Maths or both will receive targeted small group numeracy and literacy interventions in order to provide consistency for pupils in relation to learning core skills across the whole curriculum. It was observed that pupils engaged in LEAP last year experienced some difficulties with catching up on core skills missed when returning to timetable once the intervention was complete.</p>
