

Examination Certificates

Exam certificates are published by exam boards in the November / March following the summer or winter examinations.

Once all certificates are received into school these will then be posted to students via signed for postage with the Royal Mail. For students who are still attending school the certificates will be kept in school for them to collect from the exams office.

Students should expect to receive certificates by the 2nd week in December or April, depending on which exam season they are waiting for.

It is very important to keep exam certificates. Employers and institutions of further education will ask to see them and, if lost, it can be a costly process replacing them.
