What will I study?

Year 1

Students will have the opportunity to experiment, explore and develop skills in a range of techniques to produce creative outcomes.

Students will analyse, interpret, investigate and respond to a theme of their choice using the work of Artists and other cultures to create responses that are personal and meaningful in a range of creative media

Year 2

Students complete their personal investigation with a final response and a written element which supports the practical work.

January of year 13 students are given the exam paper and select a theme on which to create a project. A final response is created from this in a 15-hour dedicated time period.

All work is marked against the Assessment Objectives (AO1, AO2, AO3, AO4)

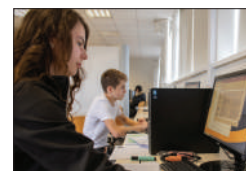
