

Year 11 Destination Report: 2019 Cohort

The cohort were offered a variety of interventions to support them in achieving positive destinations. In addition to the careers element of PDC, students were also offered the opportunity to take part in -

- CV sessions
- Apprenticeship clinics
- Careers Fair
- Online application form writing sessions

Students were offered formal careers interviews with Adviza¹, and informal support with Mrs Christiansen – Careers Lead.

The chart below represents the actual destinations from the 2018 cohort

All of the 2019 cohort were successfully tracked and their actual destination has been confirmed. Of the 2019 cohort, 100% of students had a positive destination. 40 students from the cohort remained on roll at Larkmead joining the 6th form. 5 students joined other school 6th forms, 3 of these were in Oxfordshire, 1 in Berkshire, and 1 in Germany.

We have 4 students who are currently in employment with no training, all 4 are working within the catering and hospitality industry. We had 3 students enrol with football academies, one in Kidlington then others with GPPS. We also have one student who has joined the Armed Forces.
