Destination trend report year 11

Main Findings –

- Overall the percentage of leavers entering a positive destination for the past 5 years has remain consistently high at
- ≥ 2012 98%
- ➤ 2013 95%
- **>** 2014 98%
- ≥ 2015 99%
- **>** 2016 − 95%
- The proportion of leavers continuing in education at Larkmead remained at a similar level over the past 5 years at around 35-45% of students stay on for 6th form at Larkmead.
- The number of students moving on to an apprenticeship in 2016 has risen to 9% from last year's 6.47%. We had an increased amount of students making enquires about apprenticeships and held more sessions to support students.
- In 2016 we saw a rise in the amount of students who are NEET. Of those students this year only 4 are actively seeking an EET destination as the others have health issues which are preventing them from moving on. Unlike previous years those students who were flagged up at potential NEET's in the summer were not offered any additional from the Early Intervention Hubs due to staff changes. This may have had an impact on out NEET figures being higher.

- The number of students going on to further education has again remained at a consistent level over the few years. 2016 saw a slight drop to 42% from 48% of 2016.
- Abingdon and Witney College remains the most popular choice for our students, with only a small amount going to Activate Learning City of Oxford College, traditionally student living in the Berinsfield locality attend Oxford College due to transport links being better.
